

A Deeper Study About the Resurrected Body of Our Lord Yahshua/Jesus

A sequel to previous resurrection studies.
Please read earlier versions on website first.

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Introduction

In a previous study of the resurrection I made some statements regarding the resurrected body of our Lord Yahshua/Jesus that some diligent Bible believers challenged me about. I applauded them for taking the time to check up and to go about proving all things and to hold fast to what they confirm is true. Paul encouraged his disciples and audience to be wise and check all preaching and teaching.

*Acts 17:11 These were more noble than those in Thessalonica, in that they received the word with all readiness of mind, and **searched the scriptures daily, whether those things were so.***

*2Timothy 2:15 Study to show yourself approved unto God, a workman that needs not to be ashamed, **rightly dividing the word of truth.***

One of the reasons for being challenged is that readers thought I didn't provide enough evidence or scriptural proof to back up some of my statements. For this I apologise. However, I do not apologise for anything I do/did back up with two or three witnesses.

The Resurrected Body of Messiah Yahshua/Jesus

To have a grasp or understanding of the resurrection, really starts by having a good understanding of our Lord Yahshua who is the Resurrection.

*John 11:25 Jesus said unto her, **I am the resurrection, and the life: he that believes in Me, though he were dead, yet shall he live: 26 And whosoever lives and believes in Me shall never die.** Do you believe this?*

So, the answer to being resurrected is believing the Son of YHWH is the Anointed One and being in Him. He indeed is alive for ever more.

*1 John 5:11 And this is the record, that God has given to us eternal life, and **this life is in His Son.***

*12 **He that has the Son has life;** and he that has not the Son of God has not life.*

*John 14:6 Jesus said unto him, **I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man comes unto the Father, but by Me.***

We see from the above verses, that **true life (eternal life)** is not the physical soul life the animal kingdom and mankind experience. That type of life is mentioned in Genesis chapters 1 and 2. Check in the Hebrew (eg. Strong's concordance for individual words) because a lot of translations don't correctly translate what the original says.

02416 חַי chay (khah'- ee)

Authorized or King James translates this word as -live 197, life

144, beast 76, alive 31, creature 15, running 7, living thing 6, raw 6, misc 19; 501

*Genesis 1:20 And God said, Let the waters bring forth abundantly the moving creature that has **life** <02416>, and fowl that may fly above the earth in the open firmament of heaven.*

*Genesis 1:21 And God created great whales, and every **living** <02416> creature that moves, which the waters brought forth abundantly, after their kind, and every winged fowl after his kind: and God saw that it was good.*

*Genesis 1:24 And God said, Let the earth bring forth the **living** <02416> creature after his kind, cattle, and creeping thing, and **beast** <02416> of the earth after his kind: and it was so.*

*Genesis 1:25 And God made the **beast** <02416> of the earth after his kind, and cattle after their kind, and everything that creeps upon the earth after his kind: and God saw that it was good.*

*Genesis 1:28 And God blessed them, and God said unto them, Be fruitful, and multiply, and replenish the earth, and subdue it: and have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over every **living thing** <02416> that moves upon the earth.*

*Genesis 1:30 And to every **beast (living)** <02416> of the earth, and to every fowl of the air, and to everything that creeps upon the earth, wherein there is **life** <02416>, I have given every green herb for meat: and it was so.*

*Genesis 2:7 And YHWH God formed man of the dust of the ground, and breathed into his nostrils the breath of **life** <02416>; and man became a living <02416> soul.*

Genesis 2:9 And out of the ground made YHWH God to grow

*every tree that is pleasant to the sight, and good for food; the tree of **life** <02416> also in the midst of the garden, and the tree of knowledge of good and evil.*

*Genesis 2:19 And out of the ground YHWH God formed every **beast(living)** <02416> of the field, and every fowl of the air; and brought them unto Adam to see what he would call them: and whatsoever Adam called every **living** <02416> creature, that was the name thereof.*

*Genesis 2:20 And Adam gave names to all cattle, and to the fowl of the air, and to every **beast(living)** <02416> of the field; but for Adam there was not found an help meet for him.*

*Genesis 1:20 And God said, Let the waters bring forth abundantly the moving creature that has <05315> **life**, and fowl that may fly above the earth in the open firmament of heaven.*

*Genesis 1:21 And God created great whales, and every **living***

creature <05315> that moves, which the waters brought forth abundantly, after their kind, and every winged fowl after his kind: and God saw that it was good.

Genesis 1:24 And God said, Let the earth bring forth the **living creature** <05315> after his kind, cattle, and creeping thing, and beast of the earth after his kind: and it was so.

Genesis 1:30 And to every beast of the earth, and to every fowl of the air, and to everything that creeps upon the earth, wherein there is **life** <05315>, I have given every green herb for meat: and it was so.

Genesis 2:7 And the YHWH formed man of the dust of the ground, and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life; and man became a **living soul** <05315>.

Genesis 2:19 And out of the ground the LORD God formed every beast of the field, and every fowl of the air; and brought them unto Adam to see what he would call them: and whatsoever Adam called every **living creature** <05315>, that was the name thereof.

Genesis 9:4 But flesh with the **life** <05315> thereof, which is the blood thereof, shall you not eat.

Genesis 9:5 And surely your blood of your **lives** <05315> will I require; at the hand of every beast will I require it, and at the hand of man; at the hand of every man's brother will I require **the life** <05315> of man.

Genesis 9:10 And with every **living creature** <05315> that is with you, of the fowl, of the cattle, and of every beast of the earth with you; from all that go out of the ark, to every beast of the earth.

Genesis 9:12 *And God said, This is the token of the covenant which I make between me and you and every **living creature** <05315> that is with you, for perpetual generations:*

Genesis 9:15 *And I will remember my covenant, which is between me and you and every **living creature** <05315> of all flesh; and the waters shall no more become a flood to destroy all flesh.*

Genesis 1:30 *And to every beast of the earth, and to every fowl of the air, and to everything that creeps upon the earth, wherein there is **life** <02416> <05315>, I have given every green herb for meat: and it was so.*

Now you may ask, “What was the point of that?”

The reason was to show you that before the resurrection, mankind from Adam onwards had the same type of life as the animal kingdom. The life is the blood or in the blood.

Genesis 9:4 *But **flesh with the life** <05315> thereof, which is the blood thereof, shall you not eat.*

Genesis 9:5 *And surely your **blood of your lives** <05315> will I require; at the hand of every beast will I require it, and at the hand of man; at the hand of every man’s brother will I require **the life** <05315> of man.*

There is another important verse to show you that this mortal life with blood is not designed for eternity and the heavenly realm.

1Corinthians 15:50 *Now this I say, brethren, that **flesh and blood cannot inherit the kingdom of God; neither does corruption inherit incorruption.***

*Hebrews 2:14 Forasmuch then as the children are partakers of **flesh and blood**, He also **Himself likewise took part of the same; that through death** He might destroy him that had the power of death, that is, the devil;*

If our Lord did not have blood He could not have died.

The purpose for Lord Yahshua taking on a human body of flesh, blood and bones was to enable Him to give His life and to sacrifice His body for our redemption, salvation and forgiveness. He is our **kinsman redeemer**. Lord Yahshua **emptied all His blood** at the whipping post and Calvary. The blood is no longer on the earth but in Heaven. Only YHWH knows how it got there.

Hebrews 12:22 But you are come unto mount Sion, and unto the city of the living God, the heavenly Jerusalem, and to an innumerable company of angels,

23 To the general assembly and church of the firstborn, which are written in heaven, and to God the Judge of all, and to the spirits of just men made perfect,

*24 And to Jesus the mediator of the new covenant, **and to the blood of sprinkling**, that speaks better things than that of Abel.*

A Lamb killed by the Israelites for sacrifice has **had the blood drained from it**. So, what would be characteristic of a lamb slain in the book of Revelation? It would be the same as a lamb slain for sacrifice in the Old Testament and the same as the Lamb slain at Calvary. They did not have blood.

Exodus 12:6 And you shall keep it(the lamb) up until the fourteenth day of the same month: and the whole assembly of the congregation of Israel shall kill it in the evening.

*7 And **they shall take of the blood**, and strike it on the two side posts and on the upper door post of the houses, wherein they*

shall eat it.

*Ex 29:16 And you shall slay the ram, and **you shall take his blood**, and sprinkle it round about upon the altar.*

*Revelation 5:6 And I beheld, and, lo, in the midst of the throne and of the four beasts, and in the midst of the elders, **stood a Lamb as it had been slain**, having seven horns and seven eyes, which are the seven Spirits of God sent forth into all the earth.*

Lord Yahshua didn't give only a portion of His blood. **He gave it all.** Furthermore YHWH, His Father didn't give any back to Him or create more. There is a greater principle applying here to show Yahshua's dependence on His Father for this new type of life He is experiencing now.

Lord Yahshua is as dependent on the life of His Father in Him as we are of having Lord Yahshua's life in us.

*1Peter 3:18 For Christ also has once suffered for sins, the just for the unjust, that he might bring us to God, being put to death in the flesh, but **quicken(ed)(made alive) by the Spirit(of God)**:*

This higher type of spiritual life could not be experienced without Lord Yahshua/Jesus dying first and experiencing this new resurrected body of flesh and bones, without blood.

There has never been such a creature in existence that has flesh, bones and the Spirit of YHWH which is immortal and incorruptible. It is unique, a new creation!

Resurrection is the transition from the carnal mortal life to the new life in Christ which doesn't depend on blood but is a new type of spiritual being owning a physical body of flesh and bones.

No other spirit beings created by YHWH own such unique bodies. Angels, principalities and powers were surprized when they learned of, or saw, Lord Yahshua's resurrected body.

Satan and his followers would not have been happy about Christ's death if they believed in, knew about or understood this new resurrected life that death and hell had no power over.

Unfortunately, those who wrongly believe that Lord Yahshua is really God in a different form will find some of these scriptures hard to follow or believe.

*Galatians 2:20 I am crucified with Christ: **nevertheless I live; yet not I, but Christ lives in me: and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by the faith of the Son of God, who loved me, and gave Himself for me.***

The fact is that this new type of life is not dependent upon the blood that keeps our old bodies going. This new life is totally relying on the Spirit of YHWH and of Lord Yahshua in us.

Romans 8:11 But if the Spirit of Him(YHWH/God) that raised up Jesus from the dead dwell in you, He that raised up Christ from the dead shall also quicken(make alive) your mortal bodies by His Spirit that lives in you.

We become like hand puppets dependent on another life or power to operate in us to fulfil YHWH's will. This life will only function by faith, love and Spirit

Life of the Spirit of YHWH in His Son supercedes the need for blood and guarantees an everlasting immortal and incorruptible life with flesh and bones.

This new resurrected body of **flesh, bones** and YHWH's **Spirit**

is a **spiritual body**, not a spirit body.

The work in those who are born from above (commonly called “born again”) is complete on the inside but not as far as the physical is concerned. The transformed, immortal, incorruptible body will be experienced at the appearing and returning of King Yahshua to earth. We who are alive will receive this new body at the same time as those who were dead in Christ and rise from their graves in their new glorified resurrected bodies.

At present, those who have died and their spirit has returned to YHWH, have received a temporary spirit body as Paul explained.

*2 Corinthians 5:1 For we know that if our earthly house of this tabernacle were dissolved, **we have a building of God, an house not made with hands, eternal in the heavens.***

*2 For in this we groan, earnestly desiring to be **clothed upon with our house which is from heaven:***

3 If so be that being clothed we shall not be found naked.

*4 For we that are in this tabernacle do groan, being burdened: not for that we would be unclothed, but **clothed upon, that mortality might be swallowed up of life.***

*5 Now He that has wrought us for the self same thing is God, who also **has given unto us the earnest of the Spirit.***

6 Therefore we are always confident, knowing that, while we Lord:

*7 (For **we walk by faith, not by sight:**)*

8 We are confident, I say, and willing rather to be absent from the body, and to be present with the Lord.

9 Wherefore we labour, that, whether present or absent, we may be accepted of Him.

The building that Paul received after he died is NOT his resurrection body. His resurrection body is received at the returning of Christ. Check 1 Thessalonians 4:13.

1 Thessalonians 4:13 But I would not have you to be ignorant, brethren, concerning them which are asleep, that you sorrow not, even as others which have no hope.

14 For if we believe that Jesus died and rose again, even so them also which sleep in Jesus will God bring with him.

15 For this we say unto you by the word of the Lord, that we which are alive and remain unto the coming of the Lord shall not prevent (old English for "go before") them which are asleep.

16 For the Lord Himself shall descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trump of God: and **the dead in Christ shall rise first:**

17 **Then we which are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds, to meet the Lord in the air:** and so shall we ever be with the Lord.

18 Wherefore comfort one another with these words.

1 Corinthians 15:35 But some man will say, How are the dead raised up? and with what body do they come?

36 you fool, that which you sow is not quickened, except it die:

37 And that which you sow, you sow not that body that shall be, but bare grain, it may chance of wheat, or of some other grain:

38 But God gives it a body as it has pleased Him, and to every seed his own body.

39 All flesh is not the same flesh: but there is one kind of flesh of men, another flesh of beasts, another of fishes, and another of birds.

40 There are also celestial bodies, and bodies terrestrial: but the glory of the celestial is one, and the glory of the terrestrial is another.

41 There is one glory of the sun, and another glory of the moon, and another glory of the stars: for one star differs from another star in glory.

42 So also is the resurrection of the dead. It is sown in corruption; it is raised in incorruption:

43 It is sown in dishonour; it is raised in glory: it is sown in weakness; it is raised in power:

44 *It is sown a natural body; it is raised a spiritual body. There is a natural body, and there is a spiritual body.*

45 *And so it is written, The first man Adam was made a living soul; the last Adam was made a quickening spirit.*

46 *Howbeit that was not first which is spiritual, but that which is natural; and afterward that which is spiritual.*

47 *The first man is of the earth, earthy: the second man is the Lord from heaven.*

48 *As is the earthy, such are they also that are earthy: and as is the heavenly, such are they also that are heavenly.*

49 *And as we have borne the image of the earthy, we shall also bear the image of the heavenly.*

50 *Now this I say, brethren, that flesh and blood cannot inherit the kingdom of God; neither doth corruption inherit incorruption.*

51 ¶ *Behold, I shew you a mystery; We shall not all sleep, but we shall all be changed,*

52 *In a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trump: for the trumpet shall sound, and the dead shall be raised incorruptible, and we shall be changed.*

53 *For this corruptible must put on incorruption, and this mortal must put on immortality.*

54 *So when this corruptible shall have put on incorruption, and this mortal shall have put on immortality, then shall be brought to pass the saying that is written, Death is swallowed up in victory.*

55 *O death, where is thy sting? O grave, where is thy victory?*

56 *The sting of death is sin; and the strength of sin is the law.*

57 *But thanks be to God, which gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ.*

I wonder if you have thought about this magnificent plan of our Heavenly Father YHWH for both His only begotten Son and us. He has brought the beginnings of two realms natural and spiritual together at the crucifixion and resurrection of His Son to make one new man... Lord Yahshua the Head and we the Body.

If you can see and understand this, you will understand the next verse.

*1Corinthians 15:45 And so it is written, The first man Adam was made **a living soul**; the last Adam was made **a quickening spirit**.*

Adam began **as clay** and was given a spirit and **the Word** began **as Spirit** and 2000 years ago was given a physical body of flesh, bones and blood.

John 1:14 And the Word was made flesh, and lived among us, (and we beheld his glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father,) full of grace and truth.

*1 John 1:1 That which was from the beginning, which we have heard, which we have **seen with our eyes**, which we have looked upon, and **our hands have handled**, of the **Word of life**;*

2 (For the life was manifested, and we have seen it, and bear witness, and shew unto you that eternal life, which was with the Father, and was manifested unto us;)

After the resurrection and the new creation both are neither one nor the other: they are spiritual. They now are flesh, bones and spirit (NO blood). Lord Yahshua is no longer spirit: he is spiritual. Through our eyes He would be the only visible being in heaven. Everything else is in spirit form.

*Luke 24:39 Behold My hands and My feet, that it is I Myself: **handle Me, and see; for a spirit has not flesh and bones, as you see Me have.***

Here are more verses about this new body which is both individual and collective.

Ephesians 5:30 For we are members of His body, of His flesh, and of His bones.

1 Corinthians 12:12 For as the body is one, and has many members, and all the members of that one body, being many, are one body: so also is Christ.

*13 For by one Spirit are we all baptized into **one body**, whether we be Jews or Gentiles, whether we be bond or free; and have been all made to drink into one Spirit.*

*14 For **the body is not one member, but many.***

15 If the foot shall say, Because I am not the hand, I am not of the body; is it therefore not of the body?

*16 **And if the ear shall say, Because I am not the eye, I am not of the body; is it therefore not of the body?***

17 If the whole body were an eye, where were the hearing? If the whole were hearing, where were the smelling?

18 But now has God set the members every one of them in the body, as it has pleased Him.

*19 **And if they were all one member, where were the body?***

*20 But now are **they many members, yet but one body.***

21 And the eye cannot say unto the hand, I have no need of thee: nor again the head to the feet, I have no need of you.

22 Nay, much more those members of the body, which seem to be more feeble, are necessary:

23 And those members of the body, which we think to be less honourable, upon these we bestow more abundant honour; and our unhomely parts have more abundant comeliness.

24 For our homely parts have no need: but God has tempered the body together, having given more abundant honour to that part which lacked:

25 That there should be no schism in the body; but that the members should have the same care one for another.

26 And whether one member suffer, all the members suffer with it; or one member be honoured, all the members rejoice with it.

*27 **Now you are the body of Christ, and members in***

particular.

*Colossians 1:18 And He(Jesus/Yahshua) is **the Head of the body**, the church: who is the beginning, the firstborn from the dead; that in all things He might have the pre-eminence.*

*Colossians 2:19 And not holding **the Head, from which all the body by joints and bands having nourishment ministered, and knit together, increases with the increase of God.***

20 Wherefore if you be dead with Christ from the rudiments of the world, why, as though living in the world, are you subject to ordinances,

*Colossians 3:1 If you then be risen with Christ(Messiah), seek those things which are above, where **Christ sits on the right hand of God.***

2 Set your affection on things above, not on things on the earth.

3 For you are dead, and your life is hid with Christ in God.

*4 When **Christ, who is our life**(Not blood), shall appear, then you shall also appear with Him in glory.*

Conclusion of this current study.

I thank those Bible believers for asking me to explain or prove more of my original statements of earlier studies. It has made me wait on Father YHWH to help me personally consolidate what the understanding of the resurrected Body of Christ in multiple ways.

Please take time to meditate and restudy without prejudice before trying to rubbish what I have presented. If I have left out some important points I would love some readers to make further suggestions of Scriptures to include in this study. We will then be further edified by the Word and continue to grow in wisdom and understanding.
