

Deeper Studies of the Lamb of GOD



A Bible study on the Son of God(YHWH), examining a number of important aspects not often preached about but are important to know and understand to help increase your love and commitment to such a Saviour.

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CONSIDERING OUR LORD YAHSHUA (Jesus)

Yahshua/Yeshua is the original name of the Son of God. The word “Jesus” has come about by translating from Hebrew to Greek to English instead of leaving the Name as it was. When the apostle Paul was persecuting the followers of Yahshua, Lord Yahshua stopped Him and blinded him and spoke to Paul in Hebrew, using His Hebrew Name “Yahshua”.

So this study will use His proper name because YHWH His Father is particular about names their meaning. For example YHWH/GOD changed Abram to Abraham.

It is safer and more honouring for those who love YHWH’S Word to use the Hebrew word which means God’s salvation.

*Acts 26:13 At midday, O king, I saw in the way a light from heaven, above the brightness of the sun, shining round about me and them which journeyed with me. 14 And when we were all fallen to the earth, I heard a voice speaking unto me, and saying **in the Hebrew tongue**, Saul, Saul, why are you persecuting Me ? it is hard for you to kick against the pricks. 15 And I said, Who are you, Lord? And he said, I am Yahshua whom you are persecuting.*






Check your imagination, expectations and traditions against Father YHWH’s Word which is the Truth.

Do you imagine Lord Yahshua to look like one of these pictures?
Tall? Fair? Dark? Handsome? Beautiful? Long haired? Unscarred?
Well proportioned? Muscly?

Or, do you believe He could be short, stocky, short haired, unattractive, with badly scarred head, hands, feet and side?

*1 Samuel 16:7 But YHWH said unto Samuel, Look not on his countenance, or on the height of his stature; because I have refused him: for **the LORD sees not as man sees; for man looks on the outward appearance, but YHWH looks on the heart.***

Do these pictures fit the description of our Lord?



*Isaiah 53:2 For He(YHWH's Son, the Lamb of YHWH) shall grow up before Him(YHWH) as a tender plant, and as a root out of a dry ground: He(Yahshua the Lamb) has **no form nor comeliness**; and when we shall see Him(Yahshua), there is **no beauty that we should desire Him(Yahshua)**.³ **He(Yahshua) is despised and rejected of men; a man of sorrows, and acquainted with grief: and we hid as it were our faces from Him; He was despised, and we esteemed Him not.***

*Psalm 22:6 **But I am a worm, and no man; a reproach of men, and despised of the people.***

Do these verses allow you to believe that there is anything about Yahshua's natural or physical appearance or features that would make you want Him as a friend?

Do these nice pictures/impressions agree with the verses you have just read? I wonder if these pictures could be pictures of satan in disguise? Does that shock you? Are we being deceived?

Is this one reason people will be slow to find the “Door “ because they are expecting someone looking like the pictures and not as someone unattractive, designed by the Father to check out those who have the seed of faith and are sheep who know the voice of their Shepherd and not go by outward looks “pleasant to the eyes”.

Even this picture is too good to match the description of our Lord Yahshua before His death. His after death appearance was even worse because of the damage done to Him on the night before and on the day of His death.



Description of satan (Lucifer..shining one)

*Ezekiel 28:17 Your heart was lifted up because of **your beauty**, you have corrupted your wisdom by reason of your brightness: I will cast you to the ground, I will lay you before kings, that they may behold you.*

*Ezekiel 31:8 The cedars in the garden of God could not hide him: the fir trees were not like his boughs, and the chestnut trees were not like his branches; nor any tree in the garden of God was like unto him **in his beauty**.*

This seems to relate the tree of the knowledge of good and evil with Lucifer and hence suggesting he/it was far more beautiful than the Tree of Life.

No wonder Adam and Eve were not attracted to, or even became aware of the Tree of Life even though they were allowed to eat of it. It also was in the middle of the garden. It was insignificant and unattractive in comparison to the other trees but far more beneficial if they had become spiritually aware of its benefits and blessings. Even if they didn't know the benefits of the Tree of Life they would have discovered them just by eating the fruit and not going by what it looked like.. They would have experienced both life and wisdom instead of knowledge and death.

Satan uses all the three basic root causes to get people's attention and to take them down the “broad road”. They are the

1. Lust of the eyes
2. The lust of the flesh
3. The pride of life

YHWH's Word warns us that these are carnal or worldly

1 John 2:15 Love not the world, neither the things that are in the world. If any man love the world, the love of the Father is not in him. 16 For all that is in the world, the lust of the flesh, and the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life, is not of the Father, but is of the world. 17 And the world passes away, and the lust thereof: but he that does the will of God abides(lives)forever.

Genesis 3:6 showed how these three worked on Eve

*6 And when the woman saw that the tree was **good for food(lust of the flesh)**, and that it was **pleasant to the eyes(lust of the eyes)**, and **a tree to be desired to make one wise(pride of life)**, she took of the fruit thereof, and did eat, and gave also unto her husband with her; and he did eat.*

Humanism thrives on these three temptations and the false leaders know how to use these to fill their churches by working on the people's pride and natural senses instead of focusing on spiritual discernment and love of hearing and studying YHWH's Word to avoid deception.

*2 Corinthians 11:13 For such are false apostles, deceitful workers, transforming themselves into the apostles of Christ. 14 And no marvel; for **Satan himself is transformed into an angel of light.** 15 Therefore it is no great thing if his ministers also be transformed as the ministers of righteousness; whose end shall be according to their works.*

How many of these false teachers, leaders and motivational speakers run the mega churches today and mislead people?

Revelation 20:10 And **the devil that deceived.....**

The worst is yet to come very soon....


*2 Thessalonians 2: 7 For the mystery of iniquity doth already work:
8 And then shall that Wicked be revealed, whom the Lord shall consume with the spirit of his mouth, and shall destroy with the brightness of his coming:9 *Even him*, whose coming is after the working of Satan with all power and signs and lying wonders,10 And*

with all deceivableness of unrighteousness in them that perish; because they received not the love of the truth, that they might be saved.¹¹ And for this cause God shall send them strong delusion, that they should believe a lie:¹² That they all might be damned who believed not the truth, but had pleasure in unrighteousness.

Is Yahshua's (Jesus') appearance even worse or less attractive after His crucifixion?



These Hollywood ideas are better than the traditional.



But even these pictures are too beautiful according to YHWH's Word, the Bible. They are not as graphic and as grotesque as they should have been to match the verses below.

*Isaiah 52:14 As many were astonished at you; his **visage (appearance) was so marred more than any man**, and his form more than the sons of men:*

Isaiah 50:6 I gave my back to the smiters, and my cheeks to them that plucked off the hair: I hid not my face from shame and spitting.

Why did YHWH/God arrange such a brutal killing ?

Isaiah 53

*4 Surely he hath borne our griefs, and carried our sorrows: yet we did esteem him stricken, **smitten of God**, and afflicted.*

*10 **Yet it pleased YHWH to bruise him**; he hath put him to grief: when thou shalt make his soul an offering for sin, he shall see his seed, he shall prolong his days, and the pleasure of YHWH shall prosper in his hand.*

YHWH's price or requirement for sin is the death and blood of a perfect man. This has been shown by Old Testament laws of sacrifice where a spotless lamb was killed and its blood was accepted by YHWH until the the blood of the real spotless perfect Lamb of YHWH arrived on earth in a body prepared for Him (Heb10:5) by His God and Father, YHWH. As there was no perfect man on earth because of Adam and Eve's disobedience, YHWH Himself had to provide a perfect man and that was His Son. However, the Son had to be tested like Adam to prove He was obedient and faithful in all circumstances that man is faced with before YHWH could allow Him to be that sacrifice and later become the everlasting High Priest of the order of Melchizedec and King of Kings.

*Hebrews 5:8 **Though he were a Son, yet learned he obedience by the things which he suffered**;9 And being made perfect, he became the author of eternal salvation unto all them that obey him;10 Called of God an high priest after the order of Melchizedec.*

As the Son of man and Lamb of YHWH , Yahshua had to be born of a virgin so no sin was passed down on Him from Adam's lineage that was carrying the curse of sin and death. He had to be **a man** to be a kinsman redeemer.

Yahshua had to live on this earth under the same temptations trials and sufferings we all are faced with daily. That means physically and mentally.

However in the thirty three and a half years appointed for Him to be here on earth to fulfill YHWH'S Will, Yahshua needed to be obedient to and fulfill all the laws of the Old Testament without breaking one.

He was not allowed to do or say His own ideas but only what His Father told Him to say and do.

John 5:30 I can of my own self do nothing: as I hear, I judge: and my judgment is just; because I seek not my own will, but the will of the Father which has sent me.

John 14:24 He that loves me not keeps not my sayings: and the word which you hear is not mine, but the Father's which sent me.

At the end of His time on earth having not broken one law nor disobeyed His Father once, on the 10 day of Nisan the people had to select a spotless lamb from the flock to be the sacrificial Passover Lamb which was to be four days later. This tenth day was the day they showed their approval that He was the King who came in the Name of YHWH. In other words they were saying He was the spotless ,blameless one, The Lamb of YHWH.

Nisan was the first month in the spiritual calendar which moved between March and April. This 10th Day of Nisan when Yahshua was thirty three and a half years old was a Saturday (Palm Saturday) NOT Sunday as traditional ignorant churches claim.

Ex 12:3 Speak ye unto all the congregation of Israel, saying, In the tenth day of this month they shall take to them every man a lamb, according to the house of their fathers, a lamb for an house:

This, the nation of Israel did just over 2000 years ago when Yahshua rode a donkey/ass into Jerusalem and the people wanted to make Him King. They were recognizing and honouring YHWH'S sinless, blameless, sacrificial Lamb to be slain four days later although they were not conscious of that at the time.

Mt 21:9 And the multitudes that went before, and that followed, cried, saying, Hosanna to the Son of David: Blessed is he that comes in the

name of YHWH; Hosanna in the highest.

Mt 21:15 And when the chief priests and scribes saw the wonderful things that he did, and the children crying in the temple, and saying, Hosanna to the Son of David; they were sore displeased,

Mr 11:9 And they that went before, and they that followed, cried, saying, Hosanna; Blessed is he that cometh in the name of YHWH:

Mr 11:10 Blessed be the kingdom of our father David, that comes in the name of YHWH, Hosanna in the highest.

Joh 12:13 Took branches of palm trees, and went forth to meet him, and cried, Hosanna: Blessed is the King of Israel that comes in the name of YHWH.

*Hebrews 9:18 Whereupon neither the first testament was dedicated without blood.19 For when Moses had spoken every precept to all the people according to the law, he took the blood of calves and of goats, with water, and scarlet wool, and hyssop, and sprinkled both the book, and all the people,20 Saying, This is the blood of the testament which God hath enjoined unto you.21 Moreover he sprinkled with blood both the tabernacle, and all the vessels of the ministry.22 **And almost all things are by the law purged with blood; and without shedding of blood is no remission.**23 ¶ It was therefore necessary that the patterns of things in the heavens should be purified with these; but the heavenly things themselves with **better sacrifices than these.***

*24 For Christ is not entered into the holy places made with hands, which are the figures of the true; but into heaven itself, now to appear in the presence of God for us:25 Nor yet that he should offer himself often, as the high priest enters into the holy place every year with blood of others; 26 For then must he often have suffered since the foundation of the world: **but now once in the end of the world has He appeared to put away sin by the sacrifice of himself.**27 And as it is appointed unto men once to die, but after this the judgment:28 **So Christ was once offered to bear the sins of many; and unto them that look for him shall he appear the second time without sin unto salvation.***

The heavenly things mentioned back in Hebrews 9:23 had to be purified with better things than the blood of sheep and goats....The Blood of God's Son, The Lamb of YHWH!

So YHWH's reason for such a brutal trial and death was to extract as much blood from His Son as He could.

The different means of extracting Yahshua's blood were

- 1. By smiting His face which possibly caused a bleeding nose.**
- 2. A crown of thorns on His head.**
- 3. Plucking His beard.**
- 4. Flogging Him while completely naked at the whipping post with a cat-o-nine-tails (cords interlaced with glass and nails to strip the flesh.)**
- 5. Nails in His hands and feet.**
- 6. A spear into His side to pierce His heart.**

His blood was presented to His Father(YHWH/God) as a once and for all payment and testimony of man's redemption and payment of His Sin(s)

Where is the Blood of Yahshua now?

Answer: In Heaven

*Hebrews 12:22 But you are come unto mount Sion, and unto the city of the living God, the heavenly Jerusalem, and to an innumerable company of angels,²³ To the general assembly and church of the firstborn, which are written in heaven, and to God the Judge of all, and to the spirits of just men made perfect,²⁴ And to Jesus the mediator of the new covenant, **and to the blood of sprinkling, that speaks better things than that of Abel.***

By the way the blood itself can testify. Believe it or not it has a voice just the same as Abel's blood has a voice. Read verse 24 above again and then...

*Genesis 4:10 And He (YHWH) said, What have you done? **the voice of thy brother's blood cries unto me from the ground.***

Did Lord Yahshua's disciples recognize Him after His resurrection from the dead?

Read the following verses carefully to see how those who had spent the last 3 years almost daily with their Lord responded to Him after He rose from the dead. It was the same body so why didn't they recognize Him?

Are the scriptures right that his face was as badly damaged as the rest of His body? Read Isaiah's prophecy again.

*Isaiah 52:14 **As many were astonished at you; his visage was so marred more than any man, and his form more than the sons of men:***

Event 1

*John 20:14 And when she had thus said, she turned herself back, and saw Jesus standing, and **did not know that it was Jesus.**15 Jesus said unto her, Woman, why do you weep? whom are you seeking? She, supposing him to be the gardener, said unto him, Sir, if you have carried him away, tell me where you have laid him, and I will take him away.16 **Jesus said unto her, Mary.** She turned herself, and said unto him, Rabboni; which is to say, Master.*

Event 2

*John 20: 24 But Thomas, one of the twelve, called Didymus, was not with them when Jesus came.25 The other disciples therefore said unto him, We have seen the Lord. But he said unto them, **Except I shall see in his hands the print of the nails, and put my finger into the print of the nails, and thrust my hand into his side, I will not believe.**26 And after eight days again his disciples were within, and Thomas with them: then came Jesus, the doors being shut, and stood in the midst, and said, Peace be unto you.27 Then said he to Thomas, Reach hither thy finger, and behold my hands; and reach hither thy hand, and thrust it into my side: and **be not faithless, but believing.**28 And Thomas answered and said unto him, My Lord and my God.29 Jesus said unto him, Thomas, because you have seen me, you have believed: **blessed are they that have not seen, and yet have believed.***

Event 3

*John 21:4 But when the morning was now come, Jesus stood on the shore: **but the disciples did not know that it was Jesus.***
5 Then Jesus said unto them, Children, have ye any meat? They answered him, No.
*6 **And he said unto them, Cast the net on the right side of the ship, and ye shall find. They cast therefore, and now they were not able to draw it for the multitude of fishes.***

7 Therefore that disciple whom Jesus loved said unto Peter, It is the Lord. Now when Simon Peter heard that it was the Lord, he girt his fisher's coat unto him , (for he was naked,) and did cast himself into the sea.

8 And the other disciples came in a little ship; (for they were not far from land, but as it were two hundred cubits,) dragging the net with fishes.

9 As soon then as they were come to land, they saw a fire of coals there, and fish laid thereon, and bread.

10 Jesus said unto them, Bring of the fish which ye have now caught.

11 Simon Peter went up, and drew the net to land full of great fishes, an hundred and fifty and three: and for all there were so many, yet was not the net broken.

12 Jesus said unto them, Come and dine. **And none of the disciples durst ask him, Who art thou? knowing that it was the Lord.**

The disciples had discovered how to know or recognize their Lord and Shepherd by His words and deeds, NOT by His appearance.

Event 4

Luke 24:13 ¶ And, behold, two of them went that same day to a village called Emmaus, which was from Jerusalem about threescore furlongs.

14 And they talked together of all these things which had happened.

15 And it came to pass, that, while they communed together and reasoned, **Jesus himself drew near, and went with them.**

16 **But their eyes were held that they should not know him.**

17 And he said unto them, What manner of communications are these that ye have one to another, as ye walk, and are sad?

18 And the one of them, whose name was Cleopas, answering said unto him, Art thou only a stranger in Jerusalem, and hast not known the things which are come to pass there in these days?

19 And he said unto them, What things? And they said unto him, Concerning Jesus of Nazareth, which was a prophet **mighty in deed and word** before God and all the people:.....

25 Then he said unto them, **O fools, and slow of heart to believe all that the prophets have spoken:**

26 Ought not Christ to have suffered these things, and to enter into his glory?

27 And beginning at Moses and all the prophets, he expounded unto them in all the scriptures the things concerning himself.

28 And they drew nigh unto the village, whither they went: and he made

as though he would have gone further.

29 But they constrained him, saying, Abide with us: for it is toward evening, and the day is far spent. And he went in to tarry with them.

30 And it came to pass, as he sat at meat with them, he took bread, and blessed it, and brake, and gave to them.

*31 And **their eyes(of their understanding and spiritual revelation) were opened, and they knew him;** and he vanished out of their sight.*

*32 And they said one to another, **Did not our heart burn within us, while he talked with us by the way, and while he opened to us the scriptures?***

33 And they rose up the same hour, and returned to Jerusalem, and found the eleven gathered together, and them that were with them,

Do you really believe the man, our Lord Yahshua, The Messiah and Son of YHWH, is resurrected (brought back to life) from the dead and is now ascended in body form to Heaven? Really! Let's check.

Have you ever really studied and thought about the resurrection and not just listened to someone's version and pop it into the back of your mind and give no further thought to it.

If you had have thought a little maybe you would have come up with more interesting questions not of doubt but aspects not covered in the account. An obvious one would be where did Yahshua get His clothes when He was raised from the dead? The linen clothes He was wrapped in at His burial were still in the tomb. That is a distraction in this study but an effort to show that maybe you haven't really thought about or studied the resurrection.

To help you start checking what you do believe and what you haven't thought about, try answering some of these questions...
(the answers are at the end of these questions)

Resurrection Questions

1. Is Yahshua still a man?
2. Does He still have flesh and bones in Heaven?
3. Does He have blood since His resurrection?
4. What can His resurrected body do that our not-yet resurrected body can't do?

5. Is Yahshua a spirit now in Heaven?
6. Is Yahshua returning to earth with the same body He left with?
7. How did Yahshua go to Heaven?
8. Has Yahshua changed back to being God?
9. If not, what is He doing in Heaven?

Resurrection answers

1. Yes. He is a man, and will be always.

*Heb 13:8 Jesus Christ **the same yesterday, and to day, and for ever.***

*1Co 15:47 The first man is of the earth, earthy: **the second man is the Lord from heaven.***

*1Ti 2:5 For there is one God, and one mediator between God and men, **the man Christ Jesus;***

2. Yes. He does have flesh and bones in Heaven.

*Luke 24:39 Behold(Look and notice) my hands and my feet, that it is I myself: handle me, and see; for a spirit has not **flesh and bones, as you see me have.***

*Acts 1:9 And when he had spoken these things, while they beheld, he was taken up; and a cloud received him out of their sight.10 And while they looked stedfastly toward heaven as he went up, behold, two men stood by them in white apparel;11 Which also said, Ye men of Galilee, why stand ye gazing up into heaven? **this same Jesus, which is taken up from you into heaven, shall so come in like manner as ye have seen him go into heaven.***

3 No. Lord Yahshua does not have blood since His death. His blood has been separated from Him and is now sprinkled in Heaven as we saw in above verses. Instead He lives by the power of YHWH: NOT His own life which was in His Blood.

*2 Corinthians 13:4 For though he was crucified through weakness, yet **he lives by the power of God.***

4 Yahshua's Body of flesh and bones is now the immortal, new spiritual body, not spirit body. This glorified body can move through solid objects

yet still eat, drink and be handled.

*John 20:26 ¶ And after eight days again his disciples were within, and Thomas with them: **then came Jesus, the doors being shut, and stood in the midst**, and said, Peace be unto you.²⁷ Then said he to Thomas, **Reach hither thy finger**, and behold my hands; and reach hither thy hand, and thrust it into my side: and be not faithless, but believing.*

Luke 24:40 And when he had thus spoken, he showed them his hands and his feet.⁴¹ And while they yet believed not for joy, and wondered, he said unto them, Have ye here any meat?⁴² And they gave him a piece of a broiled fish, and of an honeycomb.⁴³ And he took it, and did eat before them.

5 No. Lord Yahshua is not a spirit in Heaven now. He still has the same physical, spiritual resurrected body the disciples saw and handled. He will return with the same body as He had when He was taken up to Heaven.

*Acts 1:11 Which also said, Ye men of Galilee, why stand ye gazing up into heaven? **this same Jesus**, which is **taken up** from you into heaven, **shall so come in like manner as ye have seen him go into heaven.***

6 Yes. As the verse above says, "**this same Jesus**". That means He will return in the same glorified body He left in.

7 Acts 1:9,11 above says Lord Yahshua was "**taken up**".

*Acts 1:9 And when he had spoken these things, while they beheld, he (Yahshua) was **taken up**; and **a cloud received him** out of their sight.*

The disciples didn't give any details about how He went or what was used to take Him up. Whether it was by the spirit as Philip experienced in *Acts 8:39 And when they were come up out of the water, **the Spirit of the Lord caught away Philip**, that the eunuch saw him no more: and he went on his way rejoicing.*

Or by Cloud chariots....

Ps 104:3 Who lays the beams of his chambers in the waters: who makes the clouds his chariot: who walks upon the wings of the wind:

*Jer 4:13 Behold, he shall come up as clouds, and **his chariots** shall be as a whirlwind: his horses are swifter than eagles.*

We don't know. But we know His return to earth will be by the same way that He left: and there will be clouds at that time also.

8 There is nothing in the Scripture to show the Son of God was anyone else or became anyone else before or after His time on Earth. Some groups such as J.W.s even claim He was Michael. No!

Remember John 3:16 which used to be preached...

*John 3:16 For God so loved the world, that he gave **his only begotten Son**, that whosoever believes in Him should not perish, but have everlasting life.17 For God sent not **his Son** into the world to condemn the world; but that the world through him might be saved.*

Before Time and space and before creation of anything The Lamb of YHWH or Son of YHWH was **begotten** (was the firstborn of all creation) and was given the instructions authority and power to create everything visible and invisible. His Father (God) saw that the creation would be damaged by disobedience and He loved it and the people He had planned to be future sons and daughters through His Son, so His Son was already appointed to be the Saviour- The sacrificial Lamb of YHWH even before the creation took place.

*Revelation 13:7 And it was given unto him to make war with the saints, and to overcome them: and power was given him over all kindreds, and tongues, and nations.8 And all that dwell upon the earth shall worship him, whose names are not written in the book of life of **the Lamb slain from the foundation of the world.***

*Colossians 1:12 ¶ Giving thanks unto the Father, which hath made us meet to be partakers of the inheritance of the saints in light:13 Who hath delivered us from the power of darkness, and hath translated us into the kingdom of his dear Son:14 In whom we have redemption through his blood, even the forgiveness of sins:15 Who is the image of the invisible God, **the firstborn of every creature:16 For by him were all things created, that are in heaven, and that are in earth, visible and invisible, whether they be thrones, or dominions, or principalities, or***

powers: all things were created by him, and for him:17 And he is before all things, and by him all things consist.18 And he is the head of the body, the church: who is the beginning, the firstborn from the dead; that in all things he might have the preeminence.19 For it pleased the Father that in him should all fullness dwell;20 And, having made peace through the blood of his cross, by him to reconcile all things unto himself; by him, I say, whether they be things in earth, or things in heaven.

9 Our Lord Yahshua being our High priest, our once and for all time acceptable sacrifice for sin, is now seated at the right hand of His and our God YHWH interceding for us as mediator and advocate.

*Romans 8:34 Who is he that condemns? It is Christ that died, yea rather, that is risen again, who is even **at the right hand of God**, who also **makes intercession for us.***

*1John 2:1 My little children, these things write I unto you, that ye sin not. And if any man sin, we have **an advocate with the Father**, Jesus Christ the righteous:*

*1Ti 2:5 For there is one God, and **one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus;***

*Heb 8:6 But now hath he obtained a more excellent ministry, by how much also **he is the mediator of a better covenant**, which was established upon better promises.*

*Heb 7:26 For such **an high priest became us**, who is holy, harmless, undefiled, separate from sinners, and made higher than the heavens;*

*Heb 8:1 Now of the things which we have spoken this is the sum: We have such **an high priest, who is set on the right hand of the throne of the Majesty in the heavens;***

Does Yahshua still carry the scars and distortions of His crucifixion?

Zechariah 13:6 And one shall say unto him, What are these wounds in

your hands? Then he shall answer, Those with which I was wounded in the house of my friends.

John 20:27 Then he said to Thomas, Reach hither thy finger, and behold my hands; and reach hither thy hand, and thrust it into my side: and be not faithless, but believing.

Revelation 5:6 And I beheld, and, lo, in the midst of the throne and of the four beasts, and in the midst of the elders, stood a Lamb as it had been slain , having seven horns and seven eyes, which are the seven Spirits of God sent forth into all the earth.

Why would the Almighty God YHWH Who can heal the sick and create new parts of bodies leave His Son in a deformed violated state for eternity? Other saints will live in new bodies that are unmarked and whole.

Often when you see an ugly deformed or scarred person it doesn't leave a good impression. But if that deformation and scarring happened through that person saving your life, wouldn't those scars appear to you as beauty, marks of courage and unselfish love....badges of honour. Every time you saw that person and their scars and disfigurement wouldn't there be a welling up of gratitude, love, honour, respect and loyalty? Would you not feel humbled and unworthy of such a sacrifice? Consider also that you will **look** beautiful in comparison to Yahshua's scarred appearance.

Well, that is why our Heavenly Father has allowed the scars and disfigurement to remain. They are the badge of honour and memorial for us of Lord Yahshua's love, devotion, obedience, commitment and sacrifice that we could be redeemed and forgiven. They are there also for us to give glory and honour to YHWH God for His Grace and mercy for making such a sacrifice possible and acceptable. It was God that sent and gave His Son as the sacrifice.

Remember John 3:16-18 ?

16 For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life. 17 For God sent not his Son into the world to condemn the world;

*but **that the world through him might be saved.** 18 He that believeth on him is not condemned: but he that believeth not is condemned already, because he hath not believed in the name of the **only begotten Son of God.***

YHWH/God was NOT the sacrifice! YHWH did not die at Calvary as many false pastors and teachers believe and teach. God is a Spirit(Not a man) who has never been seen nor heard and cannot die. He is immortal. According to Solomon even the heaven of heavens cannot contain Him, Heaven is His throne and earth is His footstool.

Because of the Son of God's faithfulness, loyalty, humbleness and obedience His God and Father, YHWH, has exalted Him and given Him a name above every name.

Philippians 2:8-11

8 And being found in fashion as a man, he humbled himself, and became obedient unto death, even the death of the cross.9 Wherefore God also hath highly exalted him, and given him a name which is above every name:10 That at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of things in heaven, and things in earth, and things under the earth;11 And that every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.

Ephesians 1:19-23

19 And what is the exceeding greatness of his power to us-ward who believe, according to the working of his mighty power,20 Which he wrought in Christ, when he raised him from the dead, and set him at his own right hand in the heavenly places,21 Far above all principality, and power, and might, and dominion, and every name that is named, not only in this world, but also in that which is to come:22 And hath put all things under his feet, and gave him to be the head over all things to the church, 23 Which is his body, the fulness of him that fills all in all.

John 5:23

23 That all men should honour the Son, even as they honour the Father. He that honours not the Son honours not the Father which has sent him.

Hebrews 2:7

7 You made him a little lower than the angels; you crowned him with

glory and honour, and did set him over the works of your hands:

Who is in control in the above verses? YHWH/God. Who is being blessed and honoured? His Son.

*1 John 2:22 Who is a liar but he that denies that Jesus is the Christ? **He is antichrist, that denies the Father and the Son.***

Hear how all creation now honour the Lamb of YHWH

Revelation 5:12 Saying with a loud voice, Worthy is the Lamb that was slain to receive power, and riches, and wisdom, and strength, and honour, and glory, and blessing.¹³ And every creature which is in heaven, and on the earth, and under the earth, and such as are in the sea, and all that are in them, heard I saying, Blessing, and honour, and glory, and power, be unto him that sits upon the throne, and unto the Lamb for ever and ever.

Who will recognize the True Son of God at His Return? And How?

1 Corinthians 2:14 But the natural man receives not the things of the Spirit of God: for they are foolishness unto him: neither can he know them, because they are spiritually discerned.

Only Sheep recognize their Shepherd

John 10:14 I am the good shepherd, and know My sheep, and am known of Mine

By His Fruit

James 3:17 But the wisdom that is from above is first pure, then peaceable, gentle, and easy to be entreated, full of mercy and good fruits, without partiality, and without hypocrisy.

Matthew 7:16 You shall know them by their fruits. Do men gather grapes of thorns, or figs of thistles?

Matthew 7:20 Wherefore by their fruits you shall know them.

By His Words

John 10:27 My sheep hear My voice, and I know them, and they follow Me:

John 10:5 And a stranger will they not follow, but will run from him: for they know not the voice of strangers.

Jeremiah 23:28 The prophet that has a dream, let him tell a dream; and he that has My word, let him speak My word faithfully. What is the chaff to the wheat? says YHWH.

So the three ways followers will recognize their Lord, the Messiah, are by

- A** spiritual discernment (includes an inner witness)
- B** His actions (What He does that matches Bible prophecy)
- C** His words (Do they match YHWH's Word?)

A FURTHER LOOK AT YAHSHUA(JESUS) THE LAMB

Isaiah 53

4 ¶ Surely He has borne our griefs, and carried our sorrows: yet we did esteem Him stricken, smitten of God, and afflicted.

5 But He was wounded for our transgressions, He was bruised for our iniquities: the chastisement of our peace was upon Him; and with His stripes we are healed.

6 All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned everyone to his own way; and YHWH has laid on Him the iniquity of us all.

7 He was oppressed, and He was afflicted, yet He opened not His mouth: He is brought as a lamb to the slaughter, and as a sheep before her shearers is dumb, so He opens not his mouth.

8 He was taken from prison and from judgment: and who shall declare His generation? for He was cut off out of the land of the living: for the transgression of my people was He stricken.

9 And He made his grave with the wicked, and with the rich in His death; because He had done no violence, neither was any deceit in His mouth.

10 Yet it pleased YHWH to bruise Him; He(YHWH) has put Him to grief: when You shall make His soul an offering for sin, He shall see His seed, He shall prolong His days, and the pleasure of YHWH shall prosper in His hand.

11 He shall see of the travail of His soul, and shall be satisfied: by His knowledge shall My righteous servant justify many; for He shall bear their iniquities.

12 Therefore will I divide him a portion with the great, and He shall divide the spoil with the strong; because He has poured out His soul unto death: and He was numbered with the transgressors; and He bare the sin of many, and made intercession for the transgressors.

Recognize Him as God's Son.

1John 2:22 Who is **a liar** but he that **denies that Jesus is the Christ?** He is **antichrist**, that **denies the Father and the Son.**

John 3:16 For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that **whoever believes in Him should not perish**, but have everlasting life.17 For God sent not **His Son** into the world to condemn the world; but that the world through Him might be saved.18 He that believes on Him is not condemned: but he that believes not is condemned already, because he has not believed in the name of the **only begotten Son of God.**

Revelation 3:19 (**YAHSHUA SPEAKING**)As many as I love, I rebuke and chasten: be zealous therefore, and repent.20 **Behold, I stand at the door, and knock: if any man hear My voice, and open the door, I will come in to him, and will sup with him, and he with Me.** 21 To him that overcomes will I grant to sit with Me in My throne, even as I also overcame, and am set down with My Father in His throne.

It is time to acknowledge what YHWH's Son did for you at Calvary. It was your disobedience and sins He took on Himself as the sacrificial Lamb so that you could go free and forgiven. If you hear the call from within, then invite Lord Yahshua into your life as your Saviour and Lord and High Priest. He mediates and is an advocate between you and Almighty YHWH our God and His God. Without Lord Yahshua there is no way or connection to YHWH/God.

John 20:17 Jesus said unto her, Touch me not; for I am not yet ascended to my Father: but go to my brethren, and say unto them, **I ascend unto my Father, and your Father; and to my God, and your God.**

John 1:12 But as many as received Him, to them gave He power to become the sons of God, even to them that believe on His name:

*1 John 5:12 **He that has the Son has life; and he that has not the Son of God has not life.***

On Judgment Day YHWH/God will ask ,” What did you do with My Son?”

Read Psalm 2 carefully. Here are two verses from it.

*11 **Serve YHWH with fear, and rejoice with trembling.***

*12 **Kiss the Son, lest He be angry, and you perish from the way, when His wrath is kindled but a little. **Blessed are all they that put their trust in Him.*****

Do you know the Moslem god is not the one True God they say He is. Allah has no Son. Almighty YHWH does have a Son who He was willing to sacrifice to rescue you and redeem you to Himself. So, if you are a true sheep you will hear your Shepherd calling. Goats and dogs won't respond. These sheep don't need dogs to round them up either.

Lord Yahshua/Jesus is the only door and way to God

*John 14:6 Jesus said unto him, **I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me.***

*John 10:7 Then said Jesus unto them again, Verily, verily, I say unto you, **I am the door of the sheep.***

*John 10:9 **I am the door: by me if any man enter in, he shall be saved, and shall go in and out, and find pasture.***

Your Salvation has nothing to do with you and how good you think you are. If you are descendent of man then you inherited Death and condemnation because of the first man Adam. The Lamb of YHWH Who

was born of a virgin had no sin in Him and that is why He qualified to be the spotless, blameless sacrifice for your deliverance and salvation from YHWH's anger and promised punishments.

So many people have been told by a preacher, evangelist or friend that God loves them or Jesus loves them (leaving out the wicked state you are in) and if you ask Jesus to come into your heart you will get joy and peace and your worries will go and you will go to Heaven when you die (Humanistic preaching). They may even mention that God died for them on the cross, which is a common lie told by many popular and famous preachers, They are liars according to YHWH's Word, the Bible, because it doesn't say that. Check this verse.

John 3:16 says, “ *For **God(YHWH)** so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whosoever believes in Him should not perish, but have everlasting life. 17 **For God sent not His Son into the world to condemn the world;** but that the world through Him might be saved.*

The Immortal, invisible only true God didn't die! His Son did!

*John 17:3 And this is life eternal, that they might know You **the only true God, and Jesus Christ, whom You have sent**.*

You can't even come to YHWH/God or His Son unless YHWH draws you and calls you, because unless He did you wouldn't choose to because of your base nature and inherited sin.

*John 6:44 No man can come to Me, **except the Father** which has sent Me **draw him**: and I will raise him up at the last day.*

*Philippians 2:13 For it is **God which works in you both to will and to do** of His good pleasure.*

*Hebrews 12:2 Looking unto **Jesus the author and finisher of our faith;** who for the joy that was set before Him endured the cross, despising the shame, and is set down at the right hand of the throne of God.*

If or when you arrive in the presence of YHWH's Heavenly Kingdom: that is, if you die before Lord Yahshua's return to Rule on this earth as King, and someone asks, "How did you get here?"; your answer will be the same as ours. We have done nothing to gain our salvation. We have nothing to point to, saying, "Because I did this or that, or, I didn't do this or

I didn't do that."

We can only point to the lover (YHWH) and the One He sent (the Lamb), YHWH's Son(Yahshua the Messiah/Christ, the Anointed One). Any other answer that included us in the salvation plan would be disgusting pride.

Ephesians 2:8 For by grace are you saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God: 9 Not of works, lest any man should boast.

A gift is not earned nor deserved, especially Salvation.

Almighty YHWH deserves better from those He designed for His service and glory. Where is the Godly fear and reverence in today's carnal, filthy and self- indulging world. Have you really honoured YHWH with your whole mind, will, emotions, time , thoughts, finances and did as Yahshua did? Do you only do what the Lord tells you or shows what to do. I don't think so.

We are indeed in 'the days of Lot' and 'the days of Noah' ready for YHWH's wrath and the Lamb's wrath. It is hard to imagine the wrath of a lamb isn't it?

Revelation 6:16 And said to the mountains and rocks, Fall on us, and hide us from the face of him that sits on the throne(YHWH/GOD),and from the wrath of the Lamb:

John 6:29 Jesus answered and said unto them, This is the work of God, that you believe on Him(Yahshua) whom He(YHWH) has sent.
